### DRESS FOR THE OCCASION

- Appropriate shoes or boots
- Hi Vis waistcoat or arm/ankle straps if near roads
- Gloves – preferably leather or with rubberised palm

### BEWARE DANGEROUS ITEMS

- If you come across anything you are unsure about, do not touch it. Report it to your organiser who will report it to the StreetScene supervisor.
- Particular items to watch out for are needles, syringes, unidentified drums, cans/canisters of chemicals. You should not pick up broken glass either. All these should be reported.
- Do not pick up items that are too bulky/heavy and leave fly-tipping where it is and report it to your organiser.

### KEEP IN CONTACT

- Make sure you know how to get in touch with your organiser in case you need to report dangerous items or for any other reasons.
- Take a mobile phone with you if you can.

Please note that these advisory recommendations are to help you stay safe, but you remain responsible for the safety of yourself and your group.
