KEEP IT SAFE

Organiser's mobile

DRESS FOR THE OCCASION

· Appropriate shoes or boots

- Gloves preferably leather or with rubberised palm
- Hi Vis waistcoat or arm/ankle straps if near roads

BEWARE DANGEROUS ITEMS

- If you come across anything you are unsure about, do not touch it. Report it to your organiser who will report it to the Oxford Direct Services StreetScene supervisor.
- Particular items to watch out for are needles, syringes, unidentified drums, cans/canisters of chemicals. You should not pick
 up broken glass either. All these should be reported.
- · Do not pick up items that are too bulky/heavy and leave fly-tipping where it is and report it to your organiser.

KEEP IN CONTACT

- Make sure you know how to get in touch with your organiser in case you need to report dangerous items or for any other reasons.
- · Take a mobile phone with you if you can.

CHOOSE A SAFE PLACE

• Take great care if collecting near fast roads >30mph and only pick from areas where there is a footpath/cycle track. Care is also necessary when picking from banks near fast flowing or deep water. DO NOT enter flooded areas.
